## Constraints in Implementation of the MGNREGS by Different Stakeholders in Andhra Pradesh

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## **ABSTRACT**

In India, Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) is one of the major rural development programmes. Which it provides guaranteed employment to the rural households for 100 days in a year. This paper has attempted to find out the constraints faced by the MGNREGS beneficiaries in Andhra Pradesh. The important constraints faced by the beneficiaries were delay in wage payment, delay process in post office and non availability of regular works in Andhra Pradesh. Hectic process of post office is the major administration problem in Anantapur district which was delay in wage payment (81.67%) was occurring. In Mahabubnagar also delay in wage payment (100%) regarded as the main administration problem. In Srikakulum district 83.67% of stakeholders stated that delay in wage (83.67%) payment as the main administration constraint. Overall 89.44% of stakeholders indicated delayed in wage payment as the main administration constraint followed by hectic process of post office (83.33%).
